### Dental Mysteries: pulp capping, management of immature teeth, and post placement

In clinical practice, certain topics continue to perplex—even for seasoned providers. Over the past two decades, I've found that a few areas consistently spark debate, confusion, and curiosity. Among them, three stand out as the most persistently challenging: pulp capping, management of immature teeth, and post placement. These concepts not only test our clinical judgment but also push us to stay current with evolving materials, biologics, and evidence-based protocols.

This presentation will cover the detailed treatment of deep caries using direct pulp capping, focusing on the indications for capping and the latest materials and techniques that have significantly improved the efficiency and success of pulp capping procedures for the dental pulp.

Additionally, we will discuss a clear and simplified treatment option for teeth with immature roots, demystifying apexogenesis and apexification.

Finally, by popular demand, there will be a brief review of the best canals to select for post placement as it relates to endodontic anatomy. This section will also cover simple techniques to achieve maximum retention at the post-root interface.
